GOING DEEPER WEEKEND

By now, many of your colleagues in ministry have spent time studying together the material in the manual entitled Going Deeper produced by the Order of St Luke. The topics that you have studied together for the first year include: Journey to Maturity, Meditative Prayer, the Prayer of the Heart: Channels of Healing: Prayer of Faith, Anointing & Laying on of Hands, Reconciliation or the Healing of Relationships, Spiritual Discernment & Spiritual Growth, Spiritual Discernment & Ministry. You and your fellow Christians are now ready to experience all of this learning at a weekend setting that will provide you with the opportunity to learn interactively.

METHOD

A Going Deeper Weekend consists of a variety of presentations, "hands on" experience, and the opportunity to put into practice in a safe environment all that you have learned to date. Although much material is covered in the presentations, many of the truths must be "caught" rather than merely taught. Leaders are selected for their experience and expertise in the areas of physical, emotional and spiritual healing.

The emphasis for the weekend is instructional rather than a healing mission. Our time together ought to increase our awareness of the Holy Spirit's power enabling an integration and harmony within ourselves, with God, and with the world.

As we spend time together one of the natural and supernatural outcomes of the Going Deeper Weekend is the building of a healing community that is bound together in love through prayer, fellowship, a common faith, and the commitment to be the disciples of Christ in a world that is in need of the healing grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.
